Restraint and Seclusion Incidents

Beginning January 1, 2024, the state of California (AB 1466) requires school districts to post the number of students who have been physically or mechanically restrained or secluded on their websites. This includes students enrolled in general education and special education, as well as students enrolled in special education who attend nonpublic schools outside of the Little Lake City School District.

Definitions:

Physical Restraint: A personal restriction that immobilizes or reduces the ability of a pupil to move his or her torso, arms, legs, or head freely (with exceptions). This includes when staff intervene when students are engaged in a fight on campus.

Mechanical Restraint: Use of a device or equipment to restrict a pupil's freedom of movement (with exceptions). This does not include the use of devices by law enforcement officers, including SROs, for public safety purposes.

Seclusion: The involuntary confinement of a pupil alone in a room or area from which the pupil is physically prevented from leaving. This may include preventing a student's exit from a room to prevent them from harming themselves or others.
